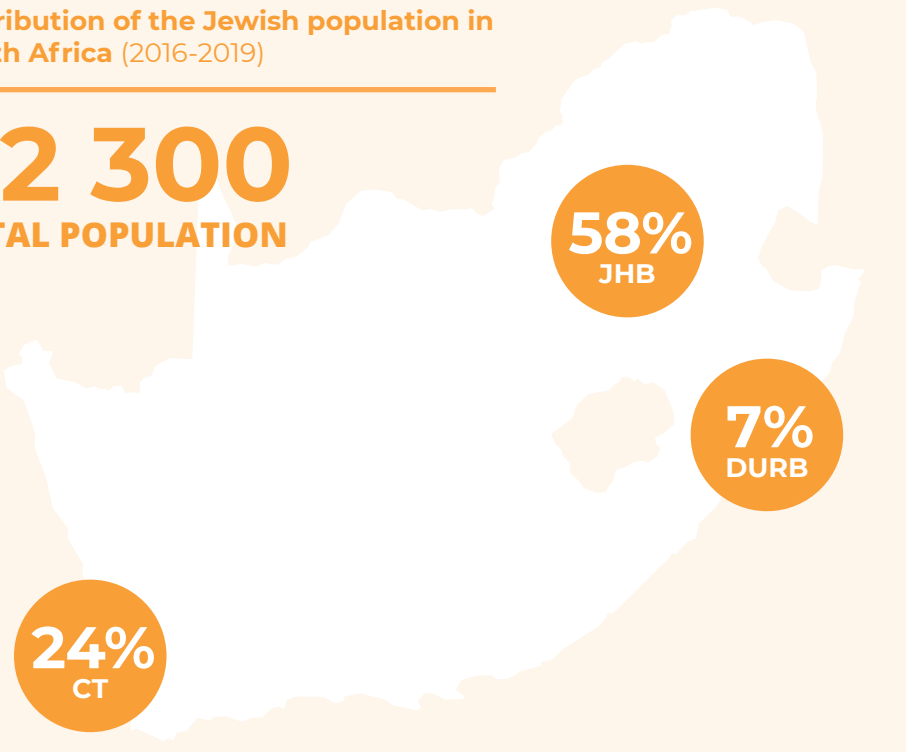


KEY FINDINGS OF THE JEWISH COMMUNITY SURVEY OF SOUTH AFRICA

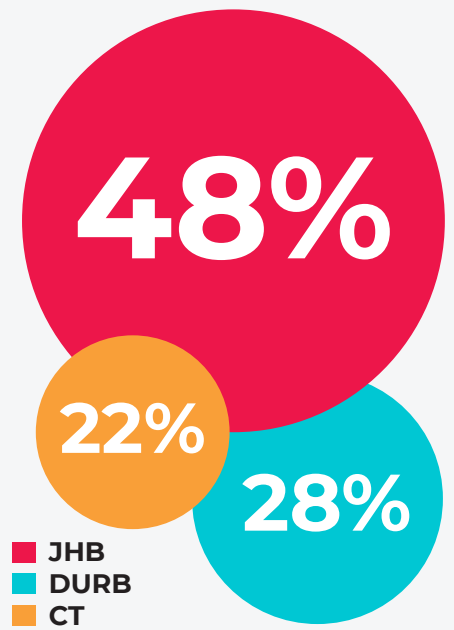
The data presented here are the results of work undertaken by the Kaplan Centre for Jewish Studies at the University of Cape Town and the Institute for Jewish Policy Research in London. Our goal was to produce a broad and deep portrait of the Jews of South Africa in 2019. This is a small selection of findings. 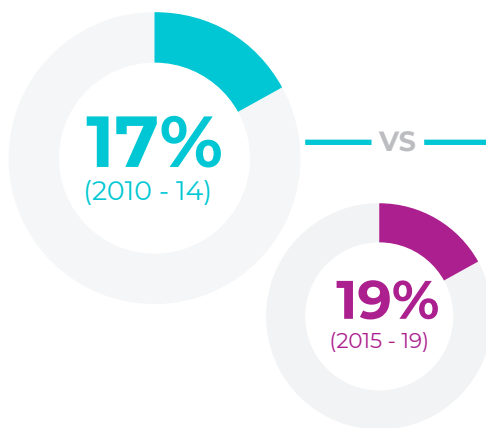

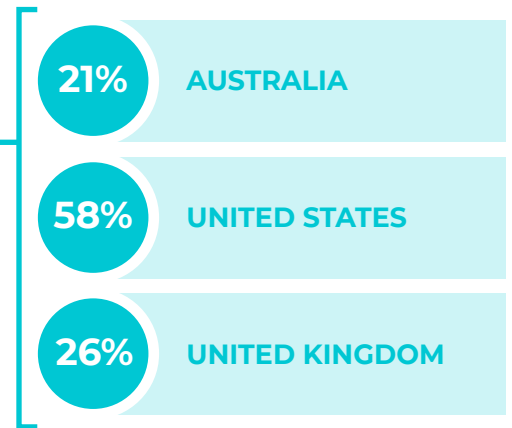

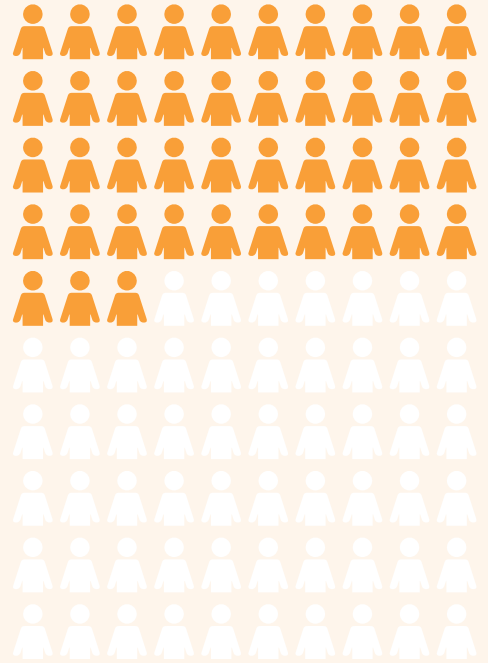

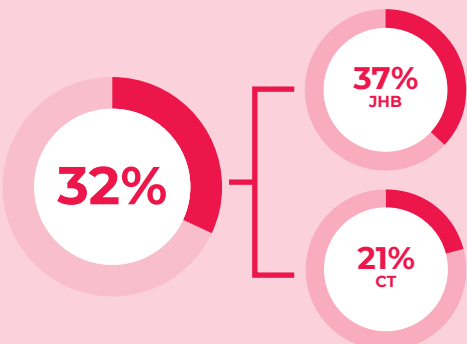
